Aliso Viejo Parkway is a demonstration area for the City's first complete street. Complete streets are designed to incorporate various modes of transportation from bikes to wheelchairs, and should be safe, comfortable, and attractive for all users.



DEVELOPING A LIVE-WORK PROJECT AT CITY WALK

A development built by Shea incorporates the City's first live-work project at City Walk. These residences, in Shea's Vantis development, allow homeowners to live above their business/store front. The project was designed to save money while you make money, eliminate the need for a commute, and allow more time to be spent with your family.
