



Adaptive Management of CA's MPA Network

Marine Protected Area :

- designed to safeguard ecosystem function and health

Adaptive Management:

- utilizes up-to-date science
- allows for flexibility and adaptivity for ongoing and anticipated needs

Área Marina Protegida:

Gestión Adaptativa:

Enhance Natural Marine Sanctuaries

National Marine
Sanctuaries:

- important for marine life and habitat conservation

OPC is working closely with federal partners:

- to identify threats to Sanctuary resources
- and opportunities to address these threats

Support Tribally-led Conservation

Apoyo de la conservación liderada por tribus



OPC will be working in partnership with California Native American tribes to establish Indigenous Marine Stewardship Areas (IMSAs).

Concept will be developed through consultation and collaboration with tribes.

Explore Other Spatial Management Measures

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30x30: Conserving 30% of California's Coastal Waters by 2030

What is 30x30?

In 2020, Governor Gavin Newsom issued [Executive Order N-82-20](#), which committed to conserving 30% of California's lands and coastal waters by 2030 as part of a broader effort to fight climate change, protect biodiversity, and expand access to nature for all Californians. In 2022, the California Natural Resources Agency (CNRA) released [Pathways to 30x30: Accelerating Conservation of California's Nature](#), which details strategies and opportunities for achieving the 30x30 target.
